

Mathematics

This term we will be focusing on the core areas of:

- Place Value
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and Division
- Year 4: Area

PSHE

This term we will use discussion and role-play to explore the topic of 'Me and My Relationships' and 'Valuing Differences'.

English

- We will be looking at diary entries.
- We will be reading traditional folk tales.
- Our Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar focus will be: Root words, prefixes and suffixes, adverbs and apostrophes for possession and omission.
- We will look at poetry – the different features and types of poetry and have a go at writing our own poems.

In Art we will study and recreate drawings, paintings and prints in the style of William Morris.

In D&T we will look at the structure of pavilions and design and create our own.

Phoenix Class – Autumn Term

Music

This term we will focus on singing. We will create a range of vocal sounds, sing in two-part harmony, sing with movement and percussion and perform a round.

We will explore branching databases and data logging.

French

We will learn animals, colours and ask and answer questions.

We will explore a range of Hindu sacred writings, looking specifically at Rama and Sita as well as a number of other important Hindu Gods and celebrations such as Diwali.

Science

Rocks

We will look at how rocks, soil and fossils are formed and distinguishing features.

Forces and Magnets

We will look at Forces and how magnets attract and repel.

Geography

Settlements and Land Use

We will look at different types of settlement, economic activity and trade links and natural resources. We will look at maps, compass points, grid references, symbols and keys to build up our knowledge of the UK and wider world.

History

Stone Age to Iron Age

We will look at the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age including: hunter-gatherers and early farmers, Bronze Age religion, technology and travel, Iron Age hill forts, tribal kingdoms, art and culture.
